We are looking forward to the seventh edition of the recreational co-ed Adult league this summer. The games will again be played Sunday evenings at 6:00 p.m.

The season will be 10 games this year, and the league will start at the conclusion of the Arsenal Youth house league. The league will begin Sunday July 10th, and run 10 consecutive Sundays up to and including September 11, 2011. All activities will be at Knox field. Games will be held on Sunday from 6:00-7:00 PM., and pick up practices will be on Wednesday nights at 6:30 pm. **YOU MUST BE REGISTERED TO PLAY IN GAMES.**

The fee for registration this year will be \$55 per participant. This will cover the cost of insurance, referee fees, and a team tee shirt jersey. Late Registrations will be accepted until June 30, 2010, but registrations post marked after June 14 will require a \$10 late fee (\$65 total). Please register early, as team composition depends on a completed player pool.

Teams will be organized in an attempt to distribute experienced players evenly throughout the teams. Accommodations will be made to place spouses on the same team, but other arrangements and pre-formed teams cannot be accommodated.
